- Be at any of the scheduled stops at the designated day and time.
- Provide the driver with a DTR ticket.
- Driver will stamp your hand for all-day access.
- Enjoy the opportunity to travel throughout the city, boarding and disembarking as many times as you want for only \$1.50.

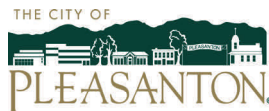

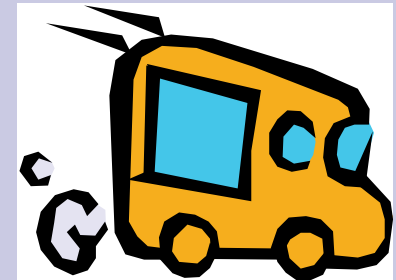

The DTR operates throughout Pleasanton with stops at the following senior housing complexes:

- Ridge View Commons
- Gardens at Ironwood
- Pleasanton Gardens
- Kottinger Place
- Stanley Junction
- Vineyard and Hacienda Mobile Home Parks

Routes include stops at popular destinations such as: Stoneridge Shopping Center, Wal-Mart, Downtown Pleasanton, Kaiser, BART, Trader Joe's, 99 Ranch Market, Valley Care Medical Center and community churches.
