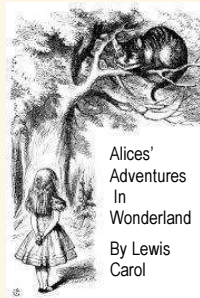
Sleeping Beauty

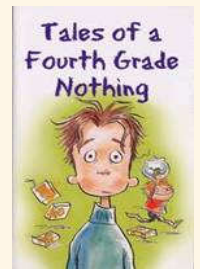

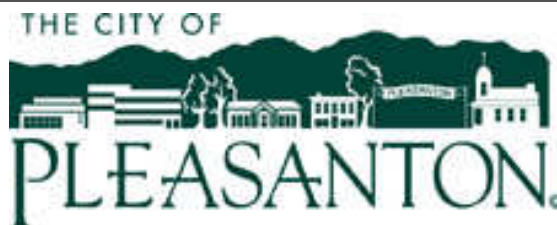
Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing
