

## Eligibility Guidelines

To ride with the **Pleasanton Paratransit Service (PPS)**, you must :

- Reside in Pleasanton or Sunol.
- Be 60 years of age (or older), or be ADA certified by the WHEELS Dial-A-Ride Staff.
- Have a completed **PPS** application on file.
- Purchase a Rider Punch Card valid for ten (10) one-way rides.
- Make reservations at least 24 hours in advance of scheduled pickup time.
- Comply with all **PPS** rules as outlined in the **PPS** Rider Guide.
- **PPS** does not provide same-day service.

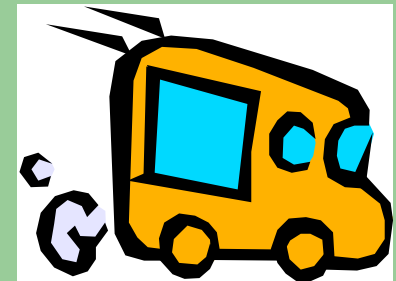

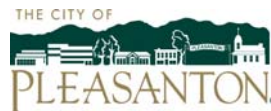

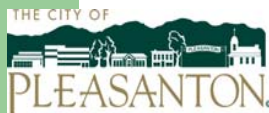

## Pleasanton Paratransit Service (PPS)

Pleasanton Paratransit Service (PPS) is funded by the City of Pleasanton, along with Alameda County Measure B sales tax revenue and Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) community transit funds.

PPS offers door-to-door, shared ride service to Pleasanton and Sunol residents, aged 60 years and older, and persons with disabilities meeting the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) eligibility requirements.



### Service Area

The PPS Service area includes Pleasanton and Sunol, with *limited service* for medical appointments to the following locations:

- San Ramon Medical Center, San Ramon
- Veterans Administration Medical Center, Livermore
- Valley Memorial Hospital/Medical Corridor, Livermore
- Kaiser, Livermore
- Medical Area on Concannon Boulevard, Livermore

Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Rider Punch Cards are sold for \$30.00, valid for ten (10) one-way rides to residents, and \$35 to non-residents at the Pleasanton Senior Center, 5353 Sunol Boulevard, Pleasanton.
