Pleasanton Paratransit Service (PPS)

The Pleasanton Paratransit Service is a reservation based program that provides door-to-door, shared-ride service for eligible Pleasanton and Sunol residents. It is a City of Pleasanton program, managed by the Department of Parks & Community Services. The goal of PPS is to provide transportation that meets the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. This law was passed to ensure that persons with disabilities have access to a variety of services, including local transportation.

Pleasanton Downtown Route (DTR)

DTR is a same-day fixed route transit service that operates throughout Downtown Pleasanton connecting local senior housing complexes to local shopping areas. Pre-registration is required through the Paratransit Program. Riders will be allowed entry on a first-come, first-served capacity. Riders use one ticket per day and have unlimited access for the remainder of the day.

How to use this brochure:

- ◆ **When arranging your medical appointments, please be very flexible with your bus schedule and notify your medical provider that you are using public transportation. We encourage medical providers to assist us in staying on time.**
- ◆ **If you require transportation to the hospital for any type of surgery, please note that Pleasanton Paratransit Service is not an appropriate option. Most hospitals require a patient to be accompanied home by a family member or friend.**
- ◆ **Don't forget that family members and friends can be a good option for some medical transport.**
- ◆ **The City of Pleasanton does not endorse or support any of the noted transportation providers. Staff recommends contacting each provider to determine the best transit option.**

Provides rides for cancer patients to their medical appointments.

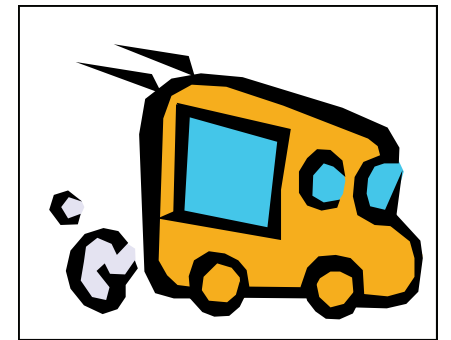
Senior Support Program of the Tri-Valley:
