1. = Some games may be played cross-court, depending on gym availability.
2. = If separate divisions, Girls 3rd grade will play on 9-foot baskets.
3. = No defense outside the 3-point line when leading by 10 or more points.
4. = No defense outside the 3-point line when leading by 15 or more points.
5. = Mandatory substitution at the 15, 10 and 5-minute marks of each half and start of the 2nd half.
6. = Beginning on the 7th team foul, the offensive player fouled is awarded one (1) point. Whenever a player is fouled while shooting, the player fouled is awarded two (2) points plus one (1) additional point if the shot is made. When a team is awarded a point as a result of a personal foul, possession of the ball is awarded to the opponent team.
7. = Double bonus rule (2 free throws) starting on 10th team foul is in effect.
