

## Adult Basketball PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

1. No Player Shall: At any time lay a hand upon, shove or strike, or threaten an official. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director. Player shall remain suspended until their case has been considered by the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from the league for one year.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for life and possible assault charges.

2. No Player Shall: Refuse to abide by an official's decision. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director. Player shall remain suspended until their case has been considered by the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from one league games and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for remainder of season.

3. No Player Shall: Be guilty of objectionable demonstration of dissent at official's decision.

Minimum Penalty: Technical.

Maximum Penalty: Removal from game.

4. No Player Shall: Discuss with an official in any manner the decision reached by such official except the manager or captain.

Minimum Penalty: Warning.

Maximum Penalty: Removal from game.

5. No Player Shall: Use unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against the body or person of an opposing player. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from two league games and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for life.

6. No Player Shall: Be guilty of a physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official, or spectator. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director. Player shall remain suspended until their case has been considered by the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from the league for one year.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for life and possible assault charges.

7. Any Player receiving two technical fouls or being ejected from a game must sit out for the next scheduled games. (Other than 5 personal fouls)

8. Any Player receiving 4 or more technical fouls during the season will be suspended from the remainder of the season.

9. Any Team receiving 6 or more technical fouls during the season will be suspended from the league and forfeit league fees.

10. No Player Shall: Be guilty of an abusive verbal attack upon any player, official, or spectator. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director. Player shall remain suspended until their case has been considered by the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from two league games and placed on probation for the remainder of season.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for remainder of season.

11. No Player Shall: Appear upon the of play at any time in an intoxicated condition. Officials are required to immediately suspend player from further play and report player to the League Director.

Minimum Penalty: Suspension from two league games and placed on probation for the remainder of season.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension for remainder of season.

12. No Player Shall: Be allowed to dunk the ball during a game or in a practice prior to a scheduled game.

Minimum Penalty: Removal from the game and suspension from one league game.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension from the league for one year.

Special Notes:

1. Any player placed on probation for the remainder of the season and reported again for violating the Code of Conduct will be suspended for the remainder of the season.
2. Any player removed from a game must leave the court and gym facility immediately. Failure to do so will carry a maximum penalty of suspension for the remainder of the season for the individual and team penalties.
3. Two technical fouls constitute suspension from the game.
4. The above player code is designed for the protection of players, officials, and spectators. Competitive recreation basketball is for your enjoyment and exercise. Sponsoring recreation agencies will tolerate repeated or flagrant violations of the player Code of Conduct.
