

# Helping Our Irrigation Meter Customers Save Water

## Commercial Irrigation System Rebate Program

The City of Pleasanton is offering rebates to commercial irrigation account customers to upgrade their irrigation system with water-efficient equipment. An efficient irrigation system can save water and lower your water bill, especially in the summer!

### Who is eligible for the rebate?

You may qualify for a rebate if you are planning to upgrade your irrigation system to save water and:

- are a City of Pleasanton water customer
- have a separate irrigation meter

### What equipment qualifies for a rebate?

- Rain Sensors – 100% of material cost.
- Drip Retrofit – 75% of material cost for a drip system, including pressure regulator that replaces an existing spray system.
- Irrigation Controllers – 50% of the cost of controllers. Controllers must have a minimum of 3 separate programs and 3 cycle starts.
- Sprinkler Head Retrofit – 50% of material cost for sprinklers that meet the following requirements:
  1. Matched precipitation rate for each station;
  2. Minimum 4" pop-up height for lawn sprinklers;
  3. Shrub heads must spray unobstructed;
  4. Pressure at heads within manufacturer specs;
  5. Head spacing for spray heads and rotors must be minimum of 75% overlap.

### How much is the rebate?

The amount of the rebate available to customers is based on the size of the commercial irrigation meter, as shown in the table below:

Meter Size:	5/8"	3/4"	1"	1 1/5"	2"	3"	4"	6"
Rebate Available:	\$60	\$90	\$150	\$500	\$700	\$1,600	\$2,500	\$3,000

### How to Receive Your Rebate:

- Download the Irrigation Upgrade Proposal Forms: Purpose Statement and Proposal form. (Review sample forms for guidance.)
- Fill out and send back the Upgrade Proposal Forms to: City of Pleasanton, Water Conservation, Utility Planning Division, P.O. Box 520, Pleasanton, CA 94566-0802. Upon satisfactory review by the City, a check for 50% of the rebate amount will be mailed to you.
- You may proceed with your irrigation upgrade project.
- When the project is complete, the owner or irrigation representative must submit:
  1. a letter certifying project completion,
  2. a copy of the original material receipts for the approved equipment installed in the meter location.

Upon acceptable review, the remaining 50% of the rebate will be mailed to the customer.
